

Frequently Asked Questions for Admission at Suryadatta Law College, Bavdhan, Pune

Here are some frequently asked questions regarding admissions for the **B.A.LL.B. (5 years)**, **BB.A.LL.B. (5 years)**, and **LL.B. (3-year) programs** at Suryadatta Law College, Bavdhan, Pune:

General Admission Queries:

Q1. What Degree programs are offered at Suryadatta Law College?

Ans. Suryadatta Law College offers the following law programs:

- **B.A. LL.B. (5-year integrated program)**
- **BB.A. LL.B. (5-year integrated program)**
- **LL.B. (3-year program)**

Q.2 What is the full form of B.A.LL.B., BB.A LL.B and LL.B?

- **BA LLB** is Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Laws.)
- **BB.A. LL.B.:** Bachelor of Business Administration and Bachelor of Laws (or Bachelor of Legislative Law)
- **LL.B.:** Bachelor of Laws (or Legum Baccalaureus, which is Latin for Bachelor of Laws)

Q.2 Why is the BA/BBA degree attached with LLB?

Ans. An LLB degree focuses on giving students the tools needed to be a lawyer. A BA degree asks them with humanities subjects. Subjects like Political Science, Sociology create a base for students to understand and excel in legal subjects with ease. An integrated BA LLB degree enables a candidate to pursue professional legal

knowledge and a degree in Law, i.e. LL.B along with securing a second degree in humanities, i.e. BA.

Similarly for the BBA degree subjects from Management Streams like Business Accounting, Principles of Management, Business Communications provides foundation knowledge for Corporate laws and Business. This enables students enothpneral mindset/

Q3. Is the BA/BBA in LLB degree syllabus same as the Plain BA/BBA Degree.

Ans. No, the syllabus for BA/BBA as a part of BA/BBA LLB course is different from the 3 year plain BA/BBA degree. The syllabus of BA/BBA subjects under the integrated course focuses on legal aspects of the concerned subjects.

Q4. Can there be a parallel entry in any year of BA/BBA LLB?

Ans. No, lateral entry and exit is not permissible as per the norms of Savitribai Phule Pune University.

Q5. Can we exit the degree after completion of BA/BBA in 2 yrs?

Ans No, since it is an integrated course exit after completing two years of the course is not permissible as per the norms of Savitribai Phule Pune University.

Q6. Are both the degrees. i.e. BA/BBA and LLB affiliated to Pune university?

Ans. Yes, after graduation students get an integrated BA LLB/BBA LLB degree from Savitribai Phule Pune University.

Q7. What are the career growth pathways after BA.LLB/BBA. LL.B?

Ans The career opportunities after completing the BA.LLB/BBA. LLB course are broad and diverse. Graduates can pursue a career as legal practitioners, advocates, or lawyers.

They can work in law firms, corporate organizations, or government agencies. They can become a specialized lawyer like Public Interest Lawyer, Government Lawyer, Private Sector Lawyer, Trial Lawyer, Family Lawyer, Immigration Lawyer, Real Estate Lawyer, Intellectual Property Lawyer, Criminal Lawyer, etc. They can also explore opportunities in legal research, academia, judiciary, and public service, providing ample avenues for growth and professional development.

Graduates can also pursue higher education such as LLM or even MBA.

Q8. What are the job opportunities after completion of BA.LLB/BBA. LLB/LLB?

Ans. A BA.LLB/BBA. LLB graduate can work in law firms, corporate organizations, banks and other financial institutions, factories and manufacturing units, media houses, builder and contractors' offices, government agencies, judicial services as a Judge, law clerk, research associate and many more.

Q9. Can I start my own business /practice/ consultation after securing my degree?

Ans Yes, you can start your own business after securing a **BA.LLB/BBA. LLB/LLB** degree, provided you pass the bar council exam.

Q10. Can I start working in the high court directly after completion of BA.LLB/BBA. LLB/LLB?

Ans Yes, you are eligible to start practicing in the High Court after completing **BA.LLB/BBA. LLB/LLB** provided you clear the All India Bar Exam and fulfill the norms of the respective courts

Q11. Does the entry of the Supreme court open after the completion of BA.LLB/BBA. LLB/LLB?

Ans Yes, you are eligible to appear for the **Advocate on Record exam** post clearance of the same.

Q 12. If I am from Science or Commerce stream can I still pursue BA.LLB/BBA. LLB/LLB?

Ans Yes, an eligible candidate from Science or Commerce stream of 12th standard/Any Graduation can pursue **BA.LLB/BBA. LLB/LLB** course, provided he has cleared CET.

Q 13. What is the eligibility for BA.LLB/BBA. LLB ?

- The Candidate must have cleared Higher Secondary School/Intermediate (10+2) or its equivalent exam from a recognised board with not less than 45% marks.
- ST and SC category candidates must have scored at least 40% marks.
- Whereas the SBC, VJNT and OBC category candidates should have scored a minimum of 42% in the qualifying exam.
- Valid CET Score .

Q 14. What is the eligibility for LLB/ ?

- The Candidate must have cleared Graduation or its equivalent exam from a recognised University with not less than 45% marks
- ST and SC category candidates must have scored at least 40% marks.
- Whereas the SBC, VJNT and OBC category candidates should have scored a minimum of 42% in the qualifying exam.
- Valid CET Score .

Q 15. Is the entrance exam compulsory for BA.LLB/BBA. LLB/LLB?

Ans. Yes, clearing MH CET Law is required for admission as per norms.

Q16. Is it possible to become a judge with a BA.LLB/BBA. LLB/LLB degree?

Ans Yes, a **BA.LLB/BBA. LLB/LLB** graduate is eligible to appear for the State Judicial Service examination to apply for the position of a judge.

Q 17. Is a specialization required after BA.LLB/BBA. LLB/LLB to work in a specific sector?

Ans No, a specialization is not required after **BA.LLB/BBA. LLB/LLB** to work in a specific sector. However, you can choose an elective subject from 3rd year onwards according to your area of interest.

Q 18. Why LLM is required after LLB?

Ans LLM can be pursued after BA LLB by those who are interested to work in academics or research fields. For other sectors, LLM degree is not mandatory for independent practice or a job.

Q19. Do we get one degree or two separate degrees?

Ans As per SPPU norms, You get first Degree (**BA./BBA**) after completing 3 years of the integrated course and a second degree after successful completion of 5 years course.

Q20. What are the valid entrance exams out of Maharashtra which are eligible for BA.LLB/BBA. LLB/LLB admissions?

Ans MAH-L.L.B. 5 Yrs. (5 years)-CET and MAH-L.L.B. 3 Yrs. (3 years)-CET is the valid entrance exam for admission to the **BA.LLB/BBA. LLB/LLB** course affiliated to SPPU.

Q 21. How can a NRI get admission for BA.LLB/BBA. LLB/LLB in Pune university?

Q22. IS CLAT entrance is valid for admission process

Ans NO , as per Savitribai Phule Pune University norms only MH-CET is the acceptable entrance exam.

Q 23 Is Suryadatta Law College affiliated and recognized?

Ans. Yes, Suryadatta Law College is affiliated to Savitribai Phule Pune University (SPPU), Pune, and is approved by the Bar Council of India (BCI), New Delhi, and recognized by the Government of Maharashtra.

Q.24 What is the admission process?

Ans. The admission process generally involves appearing for the relevant entrance exam (MH CET Law), filling out the online application form, and potentially participating in counseling rounds conducted by the State Common Entrance Test Cell, Maharashtra. Candidates then need to submit required documents and complete the admission procedure at the allotted college.

- SSC (Std. X) mark sheet
- HSC (Std. XII) mark sheet
- Graduation Mark sheet (If Applicable)
- School leaving certificate
- Migration certificate (if applicable)
- Nationality certificate
- Domicile certificate
- Caste certificate and validity certificate (if applicable)
- Non-creamy layer certificate (if applicable)
- Income certificate (if applicable)
- Aadhar card copy
- Passport-size photographs

Q29. When are the MH CET Law exams usually held?

Ans -. The MH CET entrance Exams are usually held in April /May every year. Please check the official MH CET Cell website for the most up-to-date schedule.
